

What else are Agewell involved in?

The Older People's Champion project gives older people a positive voice in the decisions that affect them. They work with both individuals and groups to provide support. They organise regular meetings to discuss important issues e.g. transport, and promote health schemes such as the health passport.

We also host Active Sandwell which aims to improve the quality of life for people aged 60 plus in Sandwell through a more active lifestyle.

The Midlife Future planning project looks at and finds ways to address the future health and social needs of people in mid-life. Part of this is an exciting new course designed to consider some of the changes people can make in mid-life.
